


The <u>Comparative</u> is normally used if you want to compare two things, people, etc:

 When we compare using short words (one or two syllables), we add -er + than at the end of the adjective.

Ex.

· He is taller <u>than</u> me.

My car is cheaper <u>than</u> your car.



When we compare 2 things or people using long words (three or more syllables), we add



more + adjective + than

Ex:

- This place is more beautiful (adj) than the other one.
- This book is more interesting than that book.



If you want to compare three or more things, people, etc. you use the <u>Superlative</u>:


When using short words (one sylabble), we add the + adjective + -est.

Ex.

- The red car is the fastest of all / in the group
- · This dinosaur is the tallest.



➤ When Using Long Words (Three Or More Syllables) We ADD The Most + Adjective



Ex.:

He is the most intelligent student in this class.

She is the most beautiful girl in the world.



> If and adjective has got I syllable and finishes with:

consonant-vowel-consonant

- · big bigger
- · hot hotter
- · thin thinner
- · fat fatter
- > If and adjective ends with a -y, we change it to -i and add -er
- · happy happier
- · funny funnier
- · easy eas<mark>i</mark>er
- · ugly uglier

Short Adjectives

	short	shorter	the short est
	high	higher	the highest
	cold	colder	the coldest
2	simple	simpler	the simplest
2	clever	cleverer	the cleverest



Long Adjectives

No of syllables	Adjective	Comparative	Superlative
4	interesting	more interesting than	the most interesting
3	beautiful	more beautiful than	the most beautiful
4	intelligent	more intelligent than	the most intelligent
3	expensive	more expensive than	the most expensive
3	dangerous	more dangerous than	the most dangerous



Irregular Adjectives

Adjective	Comparative	Superlative	
good =)	gooder than	the goodest	
	better than	the best	
bad =(badder than	the baddest	
	worse than	the worst	
far	farer than	the farest	
	farther than	the farthest	
	further than	the furthest	
little	littler than	the littlest	
	less than	the least
