- Is the third planet from the Sun.
- It is the only planet that has living things (animals, plants and humans).
- Is a small, rocky planet which supports a lot of life.
- 71% of the Earth's surface is covered with water.



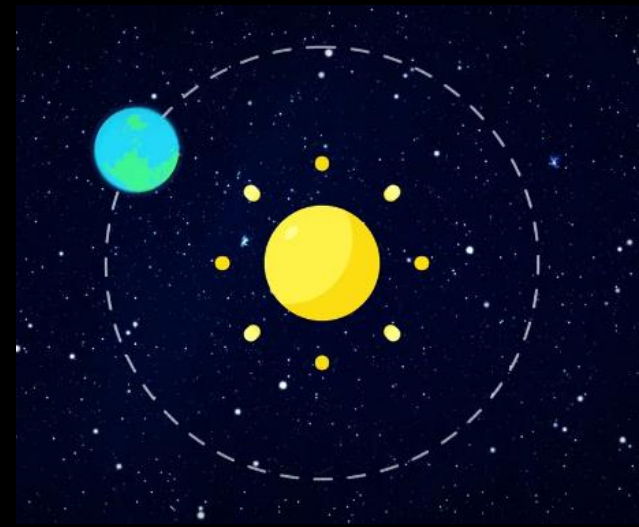
- Earth is the third planet from the sun in our Solar System.
- It is the planet where we live.
- It is between Venus and Mars.



Earth is the only planet in our solar system that **SUPPORTS LIFE**.

It has two very important things that living things need to survive: **OXYGEN and WATER!**






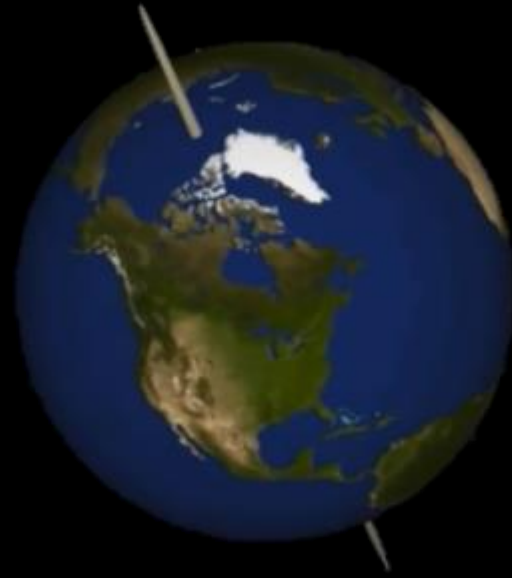
Like all the planets,

EARTH ORBITS around the Sun.

It takes 365 days (one year) to
complete one full orbit around the
Sun.



It is the only planet
that has only
ONE MOON.

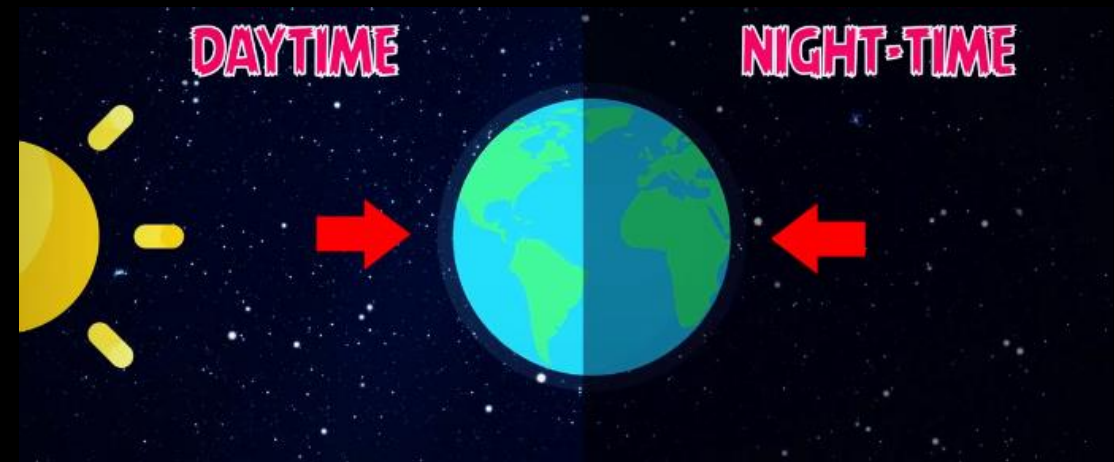


The Earth rotates around itself.
It spends 24 hours to do a round.
24 hours is a day.



The side of the Earth that faces
the **Sun** is the **day**.

The side of the Earth that faces
the **Moon** is the **night**.

THE ATMOSPHERE

The atmosphere is a huge cloud of gases – mostly oxygen and nitrogen – around Earth, protecting our planet from the sun's strong rays and from meteors.
