The "vulgar" swallow has a characteristic fork-shaped tail and a reddish neck.











## 2 TYPES OF SWALLOWS

The "cuablanca" swallow has a white neck, torso and tail.

To make the **nest** they look for covered places, for example under the roof. They use mud, trunks and stems.

If a family of swallows build their nests in your home, you can be happy: it means good luck! You should also know that swallow nests cannot be touched.












#### WHAT DO SWALLOWS EAT?




