## THE STORY

*Ithaca Palace.*

Penelope, Queen of Ithaca, watches her husband Ulysses and her son Telemachus playing soldiers.

A Greek soldier arrives at the palace and gives Ulysses a message. Agamemnon, king of kings, calls Ulysses to go and fight in the war of Troy.

Ulysses prepares and promises Penelope to return to her side.

The war of Troy begins.

The goddess Athena protects Ulysses during the war.

Ten years later the war ends and Ulysses begins his return journey to Ithaca.

During the trip he stops on the island of the Cyclops. One of them is named Polyphemus, a giant with a single eye and son of Poseidon, god of the sea.

The Cyclops encloses Ulysses and his soldiers in his cave.

With a torch, Ulysses blinds the cyclop and everyone is able to escape.

Poseidon god of the sea, full of anger, creates violent storms and promises that Ulysses will never return to Ithaca.

Ulysses's ship crashes and becomes a shipwreck on the island of the Sirens.

Ulysses and his soldiers build a new ship.

To avoid the Sirens singing, everyone covers their ears and ties Ulysses to the mast.

They finally get through but Poseidon creates another storm that makes them become shipwrecked again.

Ulysses wakes up on an island. It is Ithaca!

He disguises himself as an old man and goes to the palace where he discovers that whoever wants to marry Penelope has to draw Ulysses' bow.

When Ulysses draws his bow, the pretenders escape.

Ulysses hugs Penelope and Telemachus.

Ulysses king of Ithaca has returned.

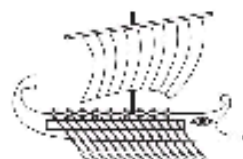

*What are your real names?*

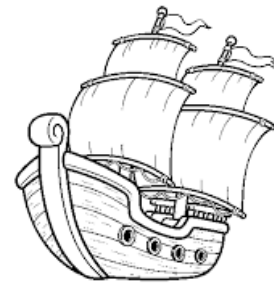
